

Creative Writing - Write an Anglo-Saxon Story or Poem

Anglo-Saxon stories and poems told us of great events, heroic stories and brave warriors. The poems did not usually rhyme, but instead used 'alliteration' (such as: the wandering wolf travelled the western road). They also used 'kennings' which is where two nouns are used to describe an object (such as 'sea-road' meaning ocean or 'battle-play' meaning fighting).

For inspiration, look up the great heroic Old English poem 'Beowulf'
